German as a foreign language

The curriculum fully complies with the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages (CEFR). The following levels are offered:

Elementary level

CEFR levels A1 and A2. No prior or little knowledge needed.

Intermediate level

CEFR levels B1 and B2. Expand your vocabulary and learn more complex grammatical structures.

Advanced level

CEFR level C1. A good preparation for DSH/TestDaF examinations.

Studying at your proficiency level

When registering on our website you can upload an existing German language certificate. Please note that this must have been issued within the past two years. You will then be placed according to the level indicated on the certificate.

If you don't have a German language certificate, you should indicate the level which you think is appropriate for you. You can choose between elementary, intermediate and advanced. To ensure that you have chosen the course that corresponds to your level, you will take a placement test on the first day of classes.

If you have no prior knowledge of the German language, please inform us, and you will automatically be placed in the elementary A1 course.

Certificate

You will receive a certificate on passing the final examination.

Lodging

You can rent a room in a student hall of residence for the duration of the summer courses. Some rooms are within walking distance to the University, others can be reached by bicycle or bus in less than half an hour. The rooms are fully furnished, with a shared kitchen; most have en-suite facilities (i.e. you have your own bathroom and toilet). Bed linens are provided but you will need to provide your own towels.

Rent: 300.00 euros

(including a cleaning charge and bed linen)

Deposit: 200.00 euros

Board

You can opt for a Mensacard, which allows you to buy inexpensive meals in the University refectory ('Mensa' in German) on campus. You can select your own menu by choosing from various different dishes every day. The cost of a complete meal in the Mensa is approximately 5.00 euros.

Mensacard deposit: 10.00 euros

Health insurance

We can offer a low-cost health insurance policy through a group contract of the University of Passau with HALLESCHE KV for the duration of the summer courses.

Health insurance fee: 9.00 euros
