In the afternoons, on the public holiday and on weekends student tutors run a special programme for the participants. The following activities are planned and included in the course fee:

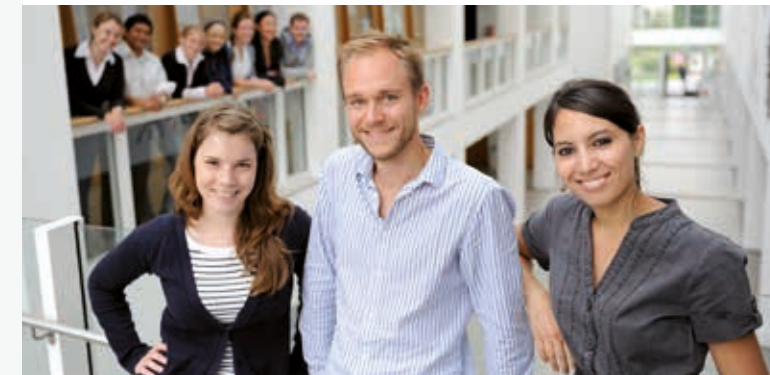
- Welcome party

German as a foreign language

The curriculum fully complies with the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages (CEFR). The following levels are offered:

Elementary level

CEFR levels A1 and A2. No prior knowledge needed.

Intermediate level

CEFR levels B1 and B2. Expand your vocabulary and learn more complex grammatical structures.

Advanced level

CEFR level C1. A good preparation for DSH/TestDaF examinations.

Your appropriate course level

When you register on our web site you can enclose an existing German language certificate (not older than 2 years). You will then be placed according to your certificate level.

If you don't have a German language certificate, you indicate the level which you think is appropriate for you. You can choose between elementary, intermediate and advanced. To be sure that you have chosen the course that corresponds to your level you will take a placement test on the first course day.

If you have no prior knowledge of the German language, please inform us, and you will automatically be placed in the elementary A1 course.

Certificate

You will receive a certificate on passing the final test.

Lodging

You can rent a single room with en-suite shower and toilet facilities in a student hall of residence hall or a shared flat.

(including a cleaning charge and bed linen)

Deposit: 200.00 euros

Board

All students receive a Mensacard which allows you to buy inexpensive meals in the University refectory (Mensa) and cafeterias on campus. The cost of a complete meal in the Mensa is approximately 5.00 euros.
