Academic German Year

The Academic German Year programme is an important building block of the university's strong international and multi-cultural orientation. It is directed at foreign students with little or no knowledge of the German language who intend to embark on a degree programme at the University of Passau or another German university.

At the end of the Academic German Year you will take the German Language Test for the Admission of Foreign Students to University (DSH). The course participants take intensive German classes five days a week, taught by experienced lecturers. The course is rounded off by fun and exciting extracurricular activities, guided by tutors who are also available to help the course participants with any questions or problems that might arise.


